## Festival of Classical Music on May 24, 2014

All entries must be postmarked before or on **May 1st, 2014**.

**Purpose:** to celebrate Classical music, and to provide students with an opportunity to perform in public.

**Adjudicators:** teachers of students participating in the Festival.

**Date of event:** May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

**Eligibility:** students of any age, level, and instrument.

**Repertoire:** one standard repertoire composition written for solo instrument or one composition written for chamber ensemble (no method books, arrangements, pop, etc.). **All music must be memorized.** Students must bring music with numbered measures.

**Entry fee:** \$25 per student from Young Talents Music School and \$30 for non-students. Write check or money order payable to Young Talents Music School.

All entries must be postmarked before or on **May 1st, 2014**. Please send bottom part of the application and the fee to: **Young Talents Music School, 4236 Winding Way, Sacramento, CA 95841.**

**Location of Competition:** Capital Christian Center, 9470 Micron Ave, Sacramento, CA 95827 (travel HIGHWAY 50 EAST, exit right on BRADSHAW Road, right on MICRON Ave).

**Dress Code:** gentlemen- dress slacks, dress shirt, ties; ladies- long or short formal dress. Dress shoes required. Bow before and after performing.

**Recording** Parents can take pictures and/or record their own child only.

**Accompanist:** If you don't have an accompanist, our school can provide one for you at \$60 ( includes 1 hour rehearsal and performance)

**Procedure:** there will be 5 recitals. Each recital will be 1 hour long with about 15 participants. At the end of each recital, performers will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. (1<sup>st</sup> place-trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> place-medal, 3<sup>rd</sup> place-ribbon). Judges' ratings are final.

**Schedule of Festival:** 9:30 -10:15 is the practice time for pianists to try the concert piano. Recitals begin at 10:30AM; 11:45AM; 1 PM; 3PM and 4:15 PM. Break from 2:15PM to 3 PM. Pianists can test concert piano during this time period. Master-Classes are from 5:30PM to 7:30PM

**Master- Classes** are conducted by piano professor Mr. Cionco from Sacramento University. **Participation in master-class is \$40.** Attendance is free. Students will receive a Certificate of Participation in the master-class.

Parents and teachers can record videos or take pictures during the master class only their own child or student.

All recitals are open to public and held in a nice and friendly atmosphere.
