MUSIC RECITAL INFORMATION

MAY 24, 2009

- n Each music recital is divided into 2-3 sessions. Your teacher is assigned one session in which all their students perform. If the time assigned does not work for you, it is possible to switch recital sessions. However, the teacher will only be at the session assigned to them.
- n The recitals are at Capital Christian Center - 9470 Micron Ave, Sacramento, CA 95827
- n The charge for participation in recital is \$10 per family. Entry fee is due May 7, 2009. There will be no charge for invited relatives, friends and guests...
- n Students, who are singing, playing the violin or another instrument that needs accompaniment, will be given information about setting up a time with the school accompanist a few weeks before the recital.
- n Each session last approximately 1 ½ hours.
- n Performers may sit anywhere they like in the auditorium.
- n Please do not leave after your child has performed. This is very rude and the students at the end of the recital deserve an audience as much as the students at the beginning of the recital.
- n Please do not talk during the performance and keep young children quiet so the performer is not distracted.
- n Please come early if you have an instrument that needs to be tuned (violin, guitar etc.)
- n Students do not have to memorize music and if they have we still strongly encourage them to bring their music in case they have any difficulties while performing.
- n Due to the number of students performing in each session, each participant is to perform only one solo piece.
- n Students should use a post-it note flag or paperclip on the piece they are playing so they don't have to find the page in the book at the recital.
- n Dress for the recital does not have to be formal, but please do not dress in immodest or sloppy clothing. The appearance of the performer always is an important part of the performance. Voice students should be aware that we do not use microphones at the recitals.
